# OUR HISTORY 36 YEARS OF SERVICE

United Peace Officers against Crime, UPAC, was founded in 1988 by Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department Sergeant Tony Campbell. His idea was based on the foundation that law enforcement could play a more proactive role in helping to prevent kids from resorting to crime and gang life. To accomplish this UPAC would provide positive role models and instructive interactions with law enforcement personnel. UPAC encourages youth to make healthy and proactive decisions, believing that fighting the causes of criminal behavior will help them cease the cycle of crime. United Peace Officers Against Crime is a community based organization made up of law enforcement officers, dedicated volunteers, community members, and parents galvanized together for the purpose of implementing evidence-based prevention techniques that build self-esteem and empowers At-Risk Youth and their families with alternatives to gang violence. UPAC's unique philosophy and partnerships give youth a different outlook on life and law enforcement.
